### CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE

### Dear Owners.

With Easter fast approaching and the second wave of coronavirus gradually receding, the last few weeks have seen an easing of the Murcia Government COVID restrictions. So much so that some level of eating out and socialising is

now possible., all be it wearing face masks, etc.

We naturally hope restrictions will continue to ease over the coming months and that by mid-late summer, within reason, some semblance of normality will have returned to the resort and the Clubhouse.

Regarding non-resident owners traveling to the resort, the UK government has said it expects to have vaccinated all adults by July. Moreover, there is talk of UK citizens being allowed to travel overseas by late May. Clearly, this possibility is reliant on there being no third wave of infections between now and then.

Meanwhile, Fernando Valdés, the Spanish Tourism Minister, has recently talked of a 'green corridor' between Spain and the UK, possibly involving a COVID passport. Potentially a significant development.

Vaccinations across Europe are progressing at a slower rate. However, as they speed up, similar travel



arrangements may apply to many other countries, both inside and outside the European Union. Hopefully, this will enable many more LMC non-resident owners to return to their properties.

In the meantime, your Committee is focussing on supporting Joaquin through this challenging period. Like all businesses

on the resort, his cashflow is under severe pressure, with overheads, utilities, food and wages, etc, to pay.

Owners can play their part by using the Clubhouse whenever possible. Every time you do, it will help Joaquin, his staff and their families. These loval, cheerful and modest people, who have served owners for many years,





There are guided tours of the museum, in English and also other languages. The Amigos of the museum, all volunteers, research and display information about the activities of the British in Cartagena throughout the centuries. Although it is currently closed to the public because of the COVID pandemic, we will let you know when the museum reopens and explain how you might arrange a personal guided tour.
